

Remarks on board Bk A. B. Fisher

 Home 534
 on 29th
 Thursday Oct 13th Lat 44-39 N
 Long 53-20 W
 Fog & middle part of this
 day having a moderate fog
 from 4 AM Bk heading N. by S
 under double reef Topsail with
 heavy squalls & rain began at
 3 PM. Had in Trough sail &
 Trough sail blowing heavy & squally
 Bk heading to the S. by E. on Starboard
 tack sail 2 sails & 2 steamers in
 bound to the Westward signalize
 us showing our Bk. off to
 right latter part lying to in a fair
 wind

Friday Oct 14th

on 29th
 534
 This day comes in with
 moderate fog at 4 AM but the
 Topsails double reef Bk heading
 S. W. at 7 AM made ship heading
 to the N. W. wind about S. W.
 some squally commenced to
 scrape Bk at 12. Stopped work
 on the coast of bad weather
 some rain sail a steamer
 latter part in opposite tack
 under close reef Topsails

on 29th

 Saturday Oct 15th Lat 43-58 N
 Long 54-35 W
 Fine part of this day Lat 43-58 N
 moderate sail from the west
 - used continued to scrape Bk
 at 8 AM took a strong sail
 from N. W. took in Trough
 Topsail stopped work on the Bk
 on account of bad weather at
 3 PM set Bk sail very rough
 with sail from about 4 PM till
 clearing N. by E. compass saw
 one steamer at 6 PM more
 moderate winds

Sunday Oct 16th Long 56-15

on 29th
 536
 This day comes in with moderate
 breeze from N. W. steering by compass
 N. by E. all hands employed
 scraping Bk at 1 AM made all
 sail sail several steamers bound
 East at 2 PM ship a steamer
 bound East from Philadelphia & got
 some papers steamer bound
 of London middle part came on calm
 at 11 PM took a light breeze
 from South steering N. by E.
