 From Monday Oct 17th Lat N
 Home 537 Long W
 29th For part of this day had
 light breeze from S. S. steering
 W. by N. saw a lot of sheep
 land East. Middle part calm
 all hands employed washing
 bone at 4 P.M. took a strong
 breeze from the Northland
 so ended steering W. by N. under topsails
 & courses

Tuesday Oct 18th Lat 41-57 N
 538 Long 63-00 W
 29th This day comes in with very
 strong breeze from about S. by E.
 and topsails all hands employed
 washing bone steering W. by N.
 saw 2 sails at 6 A.M. finished
 washing bone latter part was
 moderate at 1 P.M. gallant sail
 by the wind heading W. & N. by E.
 so ended

Wednesday Oct 19th
 539
 29th For part of this day light
 fresh breeze from W. by N.
 heading S. by E. under full sail
 and (pleasant) saw 2 shagwags
 employed washed & burned the
 bone. Trial done mid all
 part was moderate from W.
 R. heading S. by E. so ended

 540 Lat 41-08 N
 29th Long 63-48 W
 This day comes in with a light
 breeze from S. by E. heading W. by S.
 at 7 A.M. took on fore topsail
 blowing heavy with clear weather
 got off fore part of bone before
 10 A.M. under cloth sail M. topsail
 heading W. S. by E. by compass

Friday Oct 21st Lat 40-26
 541 Long 64-20
 29th For part by day under cloth
 sail M. topsail with a moderate
 breeze from S. W. by E. heading W. S. W.
 by compass at 7 A.M. set fore topsail
 cloth reef saw one shagwag & one
 sailing vessel washed off the pain
 work on the quarter weather some
 overcast latter part took in fore
 topsail and went ship heading North

Saturday Oct 22nd
 541
 29th The 24 hours blowing a heavy
 breeze from S. W. by E. took to heading
 North very heavy swell so ended saw
 one sail
