 light ship bearing W by S 1/2 S distant
 120 miles at 2 Pm Bk heading SSW
 wind moderating from about West so
 ends heading S

 4 Pm took a light breeze from
 NW with cloudy weather. Bk
 under all sail steering W. by
 compass at day light set in with
 light rain at 12 Pm Breeze gentle
 fresh from NW at 1.30 Pm
 spoke a small Port Oiler Boat
 at 14 giving her Long 67-10 W
 Lat 41-12 plotted path gradually
 sail with strong breeze steering W
 by compass with rain

 This day comes in with fine
 light breeze from NW at Bk
 heading SSW at 7 am took
 a fresh breeze from SW steering
 NW at NW and 3 steamers bound
 West. Employed Bundling Board
 quite at 12 Pm caught in squall
 from the Westward Bk under double
 reefed topsails heading to E by N
 rounded at 5 Pm got 29 Fathoms
 of water weather squally at 7 am
 took in fore topsail Bk heading
 N by W under fore sail & double
 reefed main topsail blowing a
 fair breeze NW at 8.30 Pm
 saw Gay Head Light bearing
 N 1/2 E 10 fms

 Fore part of this day weather
 the same as above at 3 am
 saw ship land about 2 miles
 off Bk heading D. S. W saw 2
 boats at 6 am set the courses
 & fore topsail making a making
 sail from NW Bk in apparent

 latter part of sail working up Gay Head
 light & saw a light in night
