S.W. at 4 P.M. Shortened sail. at sundown came to by the
wind leading to the Northward at 6 P.M. steering S.E. & E.
latter part clear and strong breeze Long 46 - 35. at 10 P.M.

Friday 21st

Begins with strong breeze from the westward and thick weather
steering S.W. Lat at 11 44. 28 not I part the same

Lat 44 30 Long 57 12 middle part rainy latter
part minor hauler to the westward with a fresh gale & by
windly course S.E.

Begins with a fresh gale from S.W. and squally
steering S.E. at 4 P.M. double reefed the top sails
Lat 45. 20 Long 55. 34 E. not I part the same

Monday 24th

Strong breeze from S.W. and hail squally steering
S.E. by E. Lat 46. 30 Long 60. 28 not I part the same

Tuesday 25th

Fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy weather steering
S.E. & S.E. by S. at sundown part gale not gale & main
rugal der Lat 48 50 Long about 64 20, not I part
the same

Wednesday 26th

Strong breeze & thick weather course S.E. by S. at
sundown Shortened sail came by the corner, made
a close reefed main top sail & hauled to the S.W.
