Sunday Jan 21st

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. & S.E.
Cloudy weather course S.E. Lat 33° 48' Long 118° 17'
Mid I part the same

Monday 22nd

Begins with light winds and fine weather
course S.E. Lat 33° 38' Long 118° 14'
middle & I part the same Wakeant Flour Boats Butte
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Tuesday 23rd

Commences with light & variable winds cloudy
heading from E by S to E by N, Lat 33° 23' Long 118° 14' middle & latter part fresh breeze and squally, ship heading from E to N.E.

Wednesday 30th

Begins with strong breeze from S.E. and
squally heading from E to N.E. Lat 34° 00' Long 118° 6'
Mid I part the same

Thursday 31st

Fresh breeze from S.W. and passing clouds
heading from E to S by E, Lat 33° 35' Long 117° 20' mid I part the same No End of sun

Friday Feb 1st

Begins with strong breeze and cloudy winds,
heading E by S, at 4 P.M. double reefed the topsails,
Lat 33° 00' Long 109° 02' mid I part the same

Saturday 3rd

Strong breeze from S. & passing clouds,
heading E by S, Lat 32° 40' Long 110° 23' middle part
the same latter part more moderate Lat 32° 40' topsails
heading E by S.

Sunday 3rd

Begins with a fresh breeze from the Southward heading E by S
to S.E. at 4 P.M. double reefed the topsails
Lat 32° 55' Long 112° middle & latter part strong breeze
& passing clouds, heading E by S.

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Monday Feb 4th

Fresh gale from the Southward and clear
at 7 P.M. more ship to the S.W. headed the main sail
& fore topsail blowing fresh, Lat 32° 46' Long 119° 35'
Mid I part the same

Tuesday 5th

There 24 hands commenced with fresh gales
from S.E. and passing clouds ship heading S.W.
Lat 33° 20' Long 112° 45' mid I part the same

Wednesday 6th

Begins with fresh gale from S.E. and passing
clouds, ship on the western tack Lat 33° 55' Long 111° 40'
Mid I part the same.

Thursday 7th

Fresh gale from Southward and passing clouds
more ship to the S.W. Lat 34° 30' Long 111° 26' mid I part
more moderate but whole topsails at 5 P.M. more
ship to the S.W.

Friday 8th

Begins with moderate breeze and fine weather
ship heading N.E. by E, Lat 34° 48' Long 111° 25' middle I part the same

Saturday 9th

Begins with light winds from S.E. and fine
weather breeze N.E. by E Lat 33° 48' Long 112° 36'
Mid part fresh breeze at daylight and the corner of
Cape Naturalist latter part calm

Sunday 10th

Light winds from S.E. and fine weather at 7
P.M. came to anchor off in Geographical Bay on 4 fathoms
water with the light anchor with a scope of 48 fathoms
3 sails on side at day light got under weigh and went
to Brinkley came to anchor about noon on 4 fathoms
of water with a scope of 48 fathoms the Java Channel
from Rotterdam to Hongkong on
