

Towards New Galena 1861
Friday March 15th

Begins with a light wind from S.W. as once fair weather at 8 P.M. the wind shifts to the S.W. blowing a heavy breeze from S.W. all day & come to by the wind on the Larboard tack under the foresail the main spruce heading from N.E. to N.W. at sundown a little more moderate a heavy sea on N.O. Observations in part heavy gales from S.W. and squally after 12 more moderate at 4 A.M. more shift to the S.W. and close reefed topsails latter part light winds from S.W. and S.E.

Saturday 16th

Begins with a light wind from S. after 3 P.M. calm Lat 44.45 course E. M & L part the same Long 144

Sunday 17th

Begins with calm & rainy weather and a part clear wind from the westward course E by N

Monday 18th

Moderate breeze from the westward and passing clouds course E by N Lat 44 30 Long 146 35 M & L part Light winds and fair weather course E.S.E. reefed the fore sail,

Tuesday 19th

Begins with Light winds from the westward in weather course E.S.E. braked water Lat 44 28 Long 148 30 M & L part part breeze from the Northward

Wednesday 20th

Begins with a fresh breeze from the Northward and pleasant with a heavy sea swell, heading to Eastward Lat 44 30 Long 151 21. Latter part the same at 11 A.M. tacked S.W. to the Northward

Thursday 21st

Begins with a fresh breeze from E.S.E. and thick weather see Simbache Lat 44 34 M & L part Light and variable winds and same rain course N.E.

Towards the Line 1861
Friday March 22nd

Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. once some squalls course N.E. Lat 44, on Long 154.08 M & L part the same

Saturday 23rd

Begins with Light winds, once fine weather course N.E. Lat 42, 40, Long 157, 54, middle part Light winds from S.W. latter part fresh breeze from S.W. heading E.N.E.

Sunday 24th

Begins with a fresh breeze from the Northward and cloudy at 4 P.M. because the Light sails a heavy sea swell Lat 42 18, Long 158, 58. M & L part fresh gales from the Northward & rainy

Monday 25th

Begins with a fresh gale from the Northward & rainy laying on the Eastward tack at sunset moderate N.O. Observations, middle part moderate breeze and passing clouds latter part Light winds from S.W. with a heavy swell course N.N.E. & N.E. by E

Tuesday 26th

Begins with a light wind from S.W. and a heavy swell from S.W. reefed the main topsail Lat 41, 42, Long 161, 38 M & L part Light and variable winds and squally heading from E to N.

Wednesday 27th

Begins with Light and variable winds & rain squally heading N.E. No Observations, middle part the same latter do strong breeze from S.W. & squally course N.N.E.

Thursday 28th

Commenced with a fresh gale from S.W. & squally course N.N.E. Lat 39, 46 Long 164, 19 M & L part the same,
