Log 136-15

Friday, Oct 4th 1861

Begins with light winds & fine weather handling
Borne goods with the Belvidere. Mice & I put the same dry
& handling same & loading C. E. & L. E.

Saturday 5th

Begins with light winds & fine weather handling
S. E. & L. E. finish the Borne about 11,000 lbs. Log 36-40 Log 134, 35
Mice & I put the same washing ship

Sunday 6th

Begins with light & variable winds loading
S. E. to L. E. Log 35. 31. Log 152. 43 Mice & I put the same
Thursday 7th Log 35. 28

Bore put palms mice & I put light and poor
S. E. & fine weather loading S. E. & L. E. in play in duty

Log 152-169 Tuesday 8th Oct 35. 10

Begins with light and fine weather
Mice & I put palms rattling under the fore rigging &
Log 34-46 Log 152. 42

Wednesday 9th

Begins with clear weather & calm, mice & I put
light winds from S. E. & fine weather course S. E. & L. E.
rattling under the fore rigging & Log 34. 23

Thursday 10th

Begins with light breezes from S. E. & fine weather
other course S. E. & L. E. Mice & I put palm breezes & fine
weather loading S. E. to S. E. with the Belvidere in company

Oct 32. 02. Friday 11th Log 151. 26

Begins with fresh breezes & fine weather mice
S. E. bearing S. E. & L. E. Mice & I put strong breezes & passing
clouds

Oct 29. 45 Saturday Oct 12th Log 150. 14

Begins with strong breezes from S. E. & passing
clouds. Loading S. E. to S. E. with the Belvidere in company
Mice & I put the same I put variable winds & fine
weather S. E. & L. E.

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Oct 27. 28. Log 147. 51 Sunday Oct 13th 1861

Begins with moderate breezes from N. E. & L. E.
rain squalls, steering S. by W. & S. E. & L. E. & L. E.
Mice & I put the same. Log 25. 16 Log 134. 19

Monday 14th

Light breezes & fine weather course S. by W.
Mice & I put winds variable & light bearing from S. E. to S.
Employed in clearing up the after hold & L. E.

Log 23. 25 Log 152. 36 Tuesday 15th

Begins with light & variable breezes mice
S. E. & L. E. & L. E. Mice & I put the same.

Oct 31-40 Log 158. 40

Wednesday 16th

Begins with light breezes & fine weather course
S. E. & L. E. Mice & I put the same at dawn we saw the L. E.
Oysee distant about 75 miles

Thursday 17th

Begins with fresh breezes & fine weather
steering in favor the L. E. at 6 P. M. took a P. M. & L. E.
& came to anchor at 8 P. M. in 9 fathoms water with the
boat hauled out. Light winds & fine weather, but a squall
came & filled it & got it a huddle

Friday 18th

Begins with calm & fine weather took 4 P. M.
Mice & I put the same got off the raft the watch on liberty

Saturday 19th

Light winds & fine weather pointing the Borne
the masted astern on liberty pointing ship & L. E.

Sunday 20th

Light winds & some showers & a heavy squall
some showers & some astern

Monday 21st

Light & variable winds & showers with a heavy
squall from N. E. pointing ship & the masted astern on liberty
