Fresh trades & fine weather got a 20 lb of potatoes
& some sugar.

Thursday 31st

Fresh trades & fine weather getting ready for sea,

Friday 1st Nov

Light winds & rain got 40 lb of potatoes
aboard all ready for a start

Saturday Nov 2nd 1861

Light winds & raining the Capt wife & children
all aboard waiting for a winter mics & I got squalls from
the ship Congress driven 600 lb sea down

Sunday 3rd

Variable winds & some rain. mics & I spoke
some waiting for a winter

Monday 4th

Begins with light trades & cloudy weather.
mics & I spoke the same

Tuesday 5th

Begins with a light breeze from the East we've got under
weigh & back outside of the reef. the home faster let go again.
in 14 fathoms water it & strong breeze again with the
home of the Green went to sea 11 the Pilot left.
I got fresh trades & fine weather strong mics & I got 24 lb

Wednesday 6th

Begins with fresh trades & fine weather off the
Isle of Omani. strong mics & I got the same strong trade
& squally breeze 20 lb

Thursday 7th

Strong trades & squally at 5 P.M. of the
club the Capt & family went ashore mics & I got
the same strong off for the Capt's father this

Friday 8th

Strong breeze & squally strong off for the
mics & I got the same

Saturday 9th

The Capt & family came aboard since the 4th when
they were & with the sea breeze land. Oct 19 1861 Nov 9 1861
I got many behind

Sunday 10th

Begins with light winds & fine weather mics
& I got mics first rain I got fine weather
