

Sailed the Coast of Chile

Wednesday Dec 18th

Begins with moderate breezes from N & fair weather came S.E. but the topsail & lower sail & mizzen & I put the same setting over the futates for the very bad with wind.

Lat 42-42,

Thursday 19th

Begins with light winds from N.W. & fair weather. Mizzen & I put light sails & fine weather came East.

Lat 43-20 - Long 160-34

Friday 20th

Begins with light winds & fine weather came S.E. but in the first part that was seen for 3 months. Mizzen & I put light breezes from the North & fair weather came E.

Lat 44-00 - Long 156-15

Saturday 21st

Begins with fresh breezes from the North & fair weather. See in back, mizzen & I put full breezes & heavy weather at N.W. in rain. Right whales came 2 but without success at 9 came 2 again. Worked at the Lar. Buoys. Back for one misadventure. Lat 44-30 - Long 151-11

Sunday 22nd

Begins with strong breezes from the North & heavy weather. Lowered for Right whales without success. Mizzen & I put the same.

Lat 44-40 - Long 153-11

Monday 23rd

Begins with moderate breezes from the North & thick fog. Mizzen put the same. I put clear & fine weather. See plenty in back & Carney. Lat 44-44 - Long 154

Tuesday 24th

Begins with light winds from N.W. & fine weather. See in back. Ship steering S.W. Mizzen & I put foggy after 2 P.M. steering S.W. partly clear. See in back.

Wednesday 25th

Begins with rainy weather & a fresh breeze from N.E. at 4 started sail on the Eastern tack.

Mizzen & I put since I have been steering E. a heavy N.E. wind. See in back. Lat 46-15 - Long 161-27

Cruising on New Zealand 1861

Thursday Dec 26th

These 24 hours commenced with a strong breeze from S.W. steering East at 3 P.M. revised a Right Whale lowered 3 Boats without success to suggest to do anything. Mizzen & I put fresh gale from S.E. to N.E. & away. Lat 46-20

Friday 27th

Begins with a fresh gale from N.E. & a heavy swell. Laying to on the Eastern tack. Mizzen & I put the same.

Lat 47-00

Saturday 28th

Begins with a fresh breeze from N.W. & foggy. Laying to the Eastern tack. Mizzen & I put moderate breezes. Thick fog still. Then partly clear. Lat 47-20 - Long 157-38

Sunday 29th

Begins with light winds & heavy weather. Laying to the E.N.E. & nothing. Mizzen & I put the same.

Monday 30th

Fresh breezes from N.W. & thick foggy weather. Laying on the Eastern tack. Mizzen & I put fresh gale from N.W. & foggy. Laying to the main topsail. Lat 47-42 - Long 149-20

Tuesday 31st

Begins with a fresh gale from N.W. & a heavy swell. Laying to on the Eastern tack.

Mizzen put the same. I put fresh breezes from the North & clear steering N.E. & in back. Reversing the main topsail. Lat 47-20 - Long 146-01 with a sea, which is a storm.
