Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup>

Begins with a moderate breeze from the  
Southwest and thick weather. Miz. part calm. Subst.  
dune davits for a Starboard Run Bunt after 4 PM  
thick and rainy miz. and Spot strong gale from  
SW to NW at 10 AM hence. Topsails are fore and  
main lower to main foremast staysail and main  
sail. Right whale Lt 45-40 Log 169

Sunday 4<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a fresh gale from NW and cloudy  
on the North side miz. and Spot light winds and  
fine weather. Heading NW NE, Lt 46-27  
Log 169.38 E.

Monday 5<sup>th</sup>

Light miz. from NW and fine weather  
miz. part snow squally. Heading to the Northward. Killer  
6 logs & a Bullock. Spot strong breeze. Lt 48-16 Log 169.40

Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup>

Have lost light and variable winds from the  
westward. Heading to the Northward. Killer miz. part calm.  
Spot strong breeze from S & E. Cloudy weather.

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Wednesday May 7<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a strong gale from E & E and a thick  
snow storm to Spit cam ferry at 2 PM. Thick in all  
sides. Under main. Spencer blowing sea in  
squalls. Heading NW & E of NW miz. part blowing and  
cloudy. See in the Between decks. Brake adrift  
sea a high time. Generally Spot variable winds  
and passing cloudy with a heavy swell  
Lt 51, Log 169.03;

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light and variable winds  
and fine weather with a heavy swell. In Pin luck  
miz. part strong gale from the Northward and snow  
squalls. Miz. part the same. Lt 50.45 Log 168.31

Friday 9<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh gale from the Northward. At  
2 PM miz. part to the N.E. miz. part light winds  
and fine weather. Spot fresh gale from SW again  
cloudy. Part No Observations

Saturday 10<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh gale from SW and heavy  
weather. Miz. part strong breeze. Pin luck  
thick weather. Spot fresh breeze. Under main storm  
from S.E. Steering NE, Lt 54-35 Log 171.16

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup>

Begins with strong breeze from S.E. and snow  
wind to gutter. Miz. part calm. Heading to the Northward. Spot  
fresh gale from the Northward and cloudy. Lt 55-45 Log 172.51

Monday 12<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a fresh gale from the Northward. At  
the Eastern tack under storm sails. Sea for sea  
miz. part light winds from the westward and fine  
weather. Killer 4 logs and a to last of the Bullock  
cause N. Men. Sifter a cutting. Lt 56, 6<sup>th</sup> Log 171.20,
