

Sunday June 8 - 1862

Boat

First Part light breeze from the South the ship running along the ice that has melted at 4 P.M. cleared up the Cape King. Boat set 20 miles to S.W. in night but in morning Middle Part light breeze from the S.W. snow running along the land to the E.S. East. Latter Part light breeze and calm from the South the ship on anchor feels nothing to S.W. At 10 A.M. spoke the Schooner Clevia of Radford 21 days from Valparaiso and set us on.

Monday 9

First Part light breeze and calm from the South at 4 P.M. set on board at 6 light breeze the ship by the wind to the W.S. West with all sails set - still by Middle Part calm from the East. At set to the East 14 miles per hour. Latter Part still cloudy with the wind from the E.S. East. 2 sail in night the ship set 25 miles to S.W.

Tuesday 10

First part fresh breeze from the E.S. and thick snow storm blowing along the land and ice to the West in company with the ship at 4 P.M. took in the main gear. Middle Part the wind to the ship by the wind to the S.W. East. Latter Part still the land got out water.

Wednesday 11

First Part the wind from the S.W. at 2 P.M. it lifted up main gear blowing set 20 miles by S.W. East and short sail. Middle & Latter Part the wind from the S.W. at the ship on anchor but more short sail still by set water.

First Part light breeze from the S.W. the ship by the wind to the S.W. East. At 1 P.M. the wind E.S. East more by to the East the ship on anchor. Latter Part light breeze from the S.W. the ice.

Friday 13

First Part fresh breeze from the South the ship by the wind to the East. Long the ice in company with the ship at 4 P.M. the ship Thomas D. Brown sent Bedford nothing for the month. Latter Part thick fog squalls the ship on anchor and sent back long the ice.

Saturday 14

First Part calm with thick fog squalls the wind from the S.W. the ship working up to the land and sent back 4 P.M. in company at 8 P.M. the ship on anchor. Latter Part light breeze from the S.W. at 8 P.M. the ship on anchor. Latter Part light breeze from the S.W. in company.

Sunday 15

First Part the wind from the S.W. at 6 P.M. the ship by the wind to the S.W. East. Latter Part light breeze from the S.W. at 8 P.M. the ship on anchor. Middle & Latter Part light breeze and calm from the S.W. the ship on anchor and sent back long the ice.
