This day first part employed
in bringing off wood and
recuttes at 5 P.M. got under way
heading E.N.E. Wind N. and
moderate latter part fresh breeze
beating to windward employed
in ships Duty

Wednesday Dec^r 3.
This day first part fresh breeze
from the E.N.E. head N. by W.
Employed in ships Duty latter
part much the same under
topsails and carriers and main
top gaffail

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
