Friday Decr 26
This Day first part Madreat Breau
and fine Wither fram W. S. W. E.
Employed in Repairing Boats and
the Main sail at 5 P.M. saw a sail
to Windward Stearing to the
Eastward latter part Much the same
at 4 A.M. made the Island of
Gadelupe and Run East to the
N. E. and at 9 A.M. left off. E. S. E.
saw the bare Topmast studensail
and the Main Top garnal studensail
put out the cutting Stage

came S. E. by E. saw a plenty of
Black fish latter part Much
the same got the anchors off of
the Bow and Bent the haines
Lat 24-45. N. Long 115-00. W.

Tuesday Decr 30
This Day first part light Breau
and fine Wither fram W. S. W. E.
came S. E. by E. Employed in ships
Outry at 6 P.M. near ship
heard W. by S. Cape Jayra Baring
E. by compass four Miles off
latter part calm and fine
Wither
