 down the Wether latter part much

Monday Jan^y No 12
 This day Employed in looking
 for Whales and Bawling at 6. P.M.
 finished Bawling Wether fresh
 Brease and a little rain latter
 part much the same and ship
 laying at anchor in Man
 War Bay

Tuesday Jan^y No 13
 This day Employed in Whaling
 M J.B. struck a calf and calf
 and saved him at 10 P.M. took
 the Whale a long side latter part
 fresh Brease from the N.W.
 at 6. d. M. cut in the Whale and
 app the Boat at 11 d. M. returned
 the ship blowing fresh run
 down fifteen hundred and
 seventy three gallons of oil into
 the tank

Wednesday Jan^y No 14
 This day fresh Brease Employed
 in Bawling all the Boat are
 Board latter part much the same

Thursday Jan^y No 15
 This day fresh Brease from the
 N.W. Employed in Bawling latter
 part Employed in looking for
