in Bending sails and ships
Outy latter part Employed in
Washing ship

Saturday Feb^y 28
This Day fine Weather and light
Breeze Employed in Washing
ships latter part Weather much the
same at 4 P.M. got under way
and came and passed the headles
all sail and Wind N.W. came S.W.
got a sight the Lagoon by Chronometer
Was 112-05 W. found the Chronometer

Employed in putting on Mast
coats and ships Outy latter part
light Breeze from the N.W. came
S.W. Employed in repairing the
sparsail Lat 21-43 N. Long 153-04 W.

Wednesday March 4
This Day light Breeze and fine
Weather from the N.W. head
S.W. Employed in repairing
the fore sail latter part much
the same Lat 21-32 N.
