Friday June 19
This Day first part light Breeze
and thick Weather from the S.E.
heading to the W. latter part much
the same saw same ice

Saturday June 20
This Day first part light Breeze
from the S. heading to the W.
Seven ships in sight all looking
for Whales and gaining latter
part blowing fresh from
the E.S.E. at 4 o'clock Double Reefed
the Topsails at 6 o'clock furled
the fore Topail

Sunday June 21
This Day first part fresh Breeze
and thick Weather from the
E.S.E. head to the S.W. at 7 P.M.
land in sight Baring's Island under
Double Reefed Main Topail
latter part Weather much the
same lat 64-45 N. long 176-00 W.

Monday June 22
This Day first part fresh
gale and clear Weather from the
E.S.E. at 6 P.M. turned and heaved
out of the Main Topail and
sat the fore Cape Baring twenty
miles off Baring Island. latter
part light Breeze

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Tuesday June 23
This Day light Breeze and
thick Weather from the E.
see all a long shore latter
part much the same

Wednesday June 24
This Day first part light
Breeze and fine Weather from
the W. heading to the E. a long
the land in company with
three another ships latter part
Weather much the same saw
several gray Backs off Plaver Bay

Thursday June 25
This Day first part light Breeze
and fine Weather from the E.
cruising off Plaver Bay fifteen
ships in sight see all a long
shore latter part fresh Breeze

Friday June 26
This Day first part fresh Breeze
and fine Weather from the E.S.E.
off Plaver Bay latter part
Wind freshened Double Reefed the
Topsails

Saturday June 27
This Day first part Breeze
Breeze and thick Weather from
the S.E. latter part much the
same
