latter part calm

Monday June 29
This day first part calm
twenty miles off Plauer Bay
thirteen ships in sight latter
part light Breeze and fine
weather from N. S.

Tuesday June 30
This day first part light Breeze
and cloudy weather latter part
calm at 4 P.M. saw several
Bawheads going N. by E into
Plauer Bay plenty of ice
going past the land

Wednesday July 1
This day first part fresh
Breeze and fine weather from
N. by S. W. latter part wind
freshened from N. S. S. W.
under topsails

Thursday July 2
This day first part fresh Breeze
and thick weather from N. S. S. W.
latter part much the same

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Friday July 3
This day first part calm and
a heavy swell running from
N. S. saw several ripsacks
latter part light Breeze and fine
weather

Saturday July 4
This day first part light Breeze
and fine weather from N. S. E.
off Plauer Bay plenty of ice in
sight going a long the land
latter part much the same
my self the water taken
sick with the Boarder camped

Sunday July 5
This day light Breeze working
into the straits plenty of ice

Monday July 6
This day first part ripsacks in
sight and a plenty of ice and
ships

Tuesday July 7
This day light Breeze and thick
weather plenty of ice and ships
working into the straits

Wednesday July 8
This day light Breeze and cloudy
weather

Thursday July 9
This day light Breeze and clear weather
off the end of the Farance Island
