staid in on the wind in company

heading W. latter part light
drizzly rain under topsails saw
plenty of Kipsackies and Wabans
lat 68-10 N long 175-00 W

Sunday August 2nd
This day first part fresh Breeze
with light drizzly rain from
the NW. head. at 1 P.M. latter part
much the same lat 68-11 N long 173-15 W

Monday Aug 3rd
This day first part light Breeze
with fog from the NW. head
at 5 P.M. saw three Bowheads
going to the W. seven ships in
sight and Bawling at 7 P.M.
cleared up Wind at 8 P.M. head
at 10 P.M. by 1 P.M. latter part much the
same all sail and Surpassed
lat 68-50 N long 174-00 W

Tuesday Aug 4th
This day first part fresh Breeze
and drizzly weather from the
at all sail and Beating to
Windward latter part light
Breeze and thick spoke the
side three Bowheads

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Wednesday Aug 5th
This day first part calm
and thick weather got a Boat
up the side latter part much
the same lat 68-55 N long 175-00 W

Thursday Aug 6th
This day first part light
Breeze and thick weather from the
at 1 P.M. saw ice heard ship
head E. N. E. spoke the Pickicunn
Whales latter part blowing fresh
with a thick fog from the NW.
at 8 P.M. made all sail left off
S. E. by E

Friday Aug 7th
This day first part fresh Breeze
and thick with rain from the
at 8 P.M. took in light sails
under topsails came at 8 P.M. by E
latter part wither much the
same at 2 P.M. luffed in on
the wind head to the E. N. E.
at 8 P.M. left off heading
S. E. lat 67-50 N long 173-30 W

Saturday Aug 8th

Breeze and fine weather from the
at 5 P.M. spoke the Wabans
and Epuratives at 9 P.M. came at 8 P.M. by E
latter part fine weather Wind
hauled to the S. saw plenty
of Kipsackies lat 67-10 N
long 171-30 W
