Friday Aug<sup>th</sup> 21  
This Day first part fresh Breeze  
with thick weather from the  
S.E. heading to the S.W. Wind  
Moderating with fine weather.  
at 4 P.M. Made all sail in company  
with the vineyard employed in  
repairing damages as well as  
possible latter part fine weather  
bare sail in sight spoke the  
Yakons and the Eperaties saw  
Knaus Whales. Lat 69-30 N. Long 174-20 W.

Saturday Aug<sup>th</sup> 22  
This Day first part fresh Breeze  
and fine weather from the S.E.  
head. E.S.E. under topsails and  
cars in company with the  
Yakons and Eperaties latter part  
thick fog Beating to Windward  
Lat 69-40 N. Long 172-45 W.

Sunday Aug<sup>th</sup> 23  
This Day first part Moderate  
Breeze and thick fog from the  
S.E. Beating to Windward in  
company with the Yakons and  
Eperaties at 4 P.M. Wind halled to  
the E.S.E. head to the S.E. clear  
weather latter part thick fog at 4 P.M.  
Wind halled to the N.W. head  
E.S.E. all sail and bare sail  
in sight cleared up  
Lat 69-02 N. Long 172-42 W.

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Monday Aug<sup>th</sup> 24  
This Day first part light  
Breeze and thick weather from  
the E.S.E. head. N.E. got two  
casks of Bread and six B.L.  
of Beef from the Yakons thick  
fog in company with the  
Yakons and Eperaties saw men  
sick with the low sea latter  
part thick with rain fresh Breeze  
Lat 69-11 N. Long 172-05 W.

Tuesday Aug<sup>th</sup> 25  
This Day first part fresh Breeze  
and thick weather with rain  
from the E.S.E. Beating to  
Windward in company with the  
Yakons and Eperaties under  
Double Reefed Topsails at 8 P.M.  
turned and reefed out of the  
Topsails latter part Wind freshed  
last reefed the fore Topsail  
surpassed Lat 69-45 N. Long 171-00 W.

Wednesday Aug<sup>th</sup> 26  
This Day first part fresh Breeze  
and thick weather from the E.  
Beating to Windward in company  
with the Yakons and Eperaties and  
nothing at 4 P.M. Wind halled to  
the S head. E.S.E. under last sail  
latter part Moderated and  
cleared up bare sail in sight  
Lat 69-25 N. Long 169-35 W.
