Saturday Oct. 10
This Day first part light Breeze
and fine weather from N.E. & E
head. S. Employed in Washing
Ship latter part much the same

Sunday Oct. 11
This Day first part calm and
fine weather Employed in Washing
Ship latter part much the same

Monday Oct. 12
This Day first part calm and
fine weather latter part weather
much the same Employed in
ships duty and mending sails

Tuesday Oct. 13
This Day first part calm
and fine weather Employed in
mending sails and ships duty
latter part light Breeze and fine
weather from N.E. Employed
in mending sails

Wednesday Oct. 14
This Day first part light
Breeze and fine weather from
N.E. came S.E. & S. Employed
in ships duty latter part fresh
Breeze and squally from N
& head S.E.

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Thursday Oct. 15
This Day first part fresh
Breeze and frequent rain
squalls from N.E. & head S.E.
Employed in ships duty
latter part much the same
at 6 A.M. saw a sail bound
to the Sandwich Islands

Friday Oct. 16
This Day first part fresh
Breeze and frequent rain
squalls from N.E. & N.E.
came S. at 6 P.M. double reefed
the topsails and took in the
courses latter part wind hauled
to the S.W. and moderated at 6 A.M.
Made the Island of Malakai
sight off Cape Oahu

Saturday Oct. 17
This Day first part calm
Employed in getting the anchors
off the Bore and bent the
chains at 7 P.M. off Cape Oahu
at 2 P.M. came to anchor in
Honolulu Harbor all well
but Misses Braunsen

Sunday Oct. 18
This Day laying in Honolulu
harbour
