calms Barbers Point bore N. 15 miles
mizell and latter part moderate breeze
steered N. W.

Thursday Nov 13
moderate N.E. trade with a heavy swell
running steered N. W. all sail set at 7 P.M.
both in light sails hauled the courses up
were ship head S.E. with the main top sail aback
mizell part the same latter part more moderate
at 1 A.M. came to anchor in 12 fathoms of water
60 fathoms of chain - at the S. of Stead

fresh trades busy at getting off
continued the same throughout and at 2 P.M.
breeze busy at getting off

fresh N.E. trades and clear weather
took on board two Boatswains several
dogs and 60 at 3 P.M. took our anchor
and stood to sea set double reefed top
sails and courses and steered S.E. by S

Monday Nov 16 -
moderate N.E. trades and fine weather
steered S.E. by S 8 1/2 all sail set middle
and latter part the same busy at setting up
rigging

Tuesday Nov 17
moderate N.E. trades and fine weather
steered S.E. busy at setting up rigging
middle part about the same latter part
squally

Lat at 4 P.M. 16° 15' N

Wednesday Nov 18
fresh N.E. trades and fine weather
steered S.E. busy at various jobs
along West Side continued the same
throughout these 24 hours

Lat at 4 P.M. 13° 55' N
Long do do 158° 35' W

Thursday Nov 19
fresh trades fine weather steered S.E.
mizell and latter part squally
with light showers

Lat at 2 P.M. 11° 48' N
Long 158° 37'
