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Sunday August the 15<sup>th</sup> 1854  
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the East  
and fine weather steering to the Southward by the  
wind No porpoises Lat 29-31 Long 57-10

Monday the 16<sup>th</sup>  
begins with light winds from the S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering to the South by the wind middle  
and latter parts steering to the Southward by the  
wind No porpoises Lat 30-34 Long 56-13

Tuesday the 17<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours light winds from the East  
and fine weather steering to the Southward by the  
wind No porpoises Lat 32-31 Long 56-00

Wednesday the 18<sup>th</sup>  
begins with light winds from the East and fine  
weather steering to the Southward by the wind middle  
and latter parts calm some blackfish lowered  
and chased but without success

No obs Lat 33-01 Long 56-58

Thursday the 19<sup>th</sup>  
begins with calm and pleasant weather middle  
part much the same latter part light winds from  
the S.E. steering to the East

Lat 33-56 Long 54-53

Friday the 20<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours light winds from the N.W. and  
fine weather steering East No porpoises

Lat 34-20 Long 53-10

Saturday the 21<sup>th</sup>  
begins with light winds from the S.W. and  
fine weather steering East middle part  
much the same latter part equally with  
rain No porpoises
