all these 24 hours light winds from the N.E.
and fine weather steering S.W. Van a Bark
Lat 16-42 Long 35-03

Saturday the 16th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N.E.
and pleasant weather steering one way and
the other Van nothing
Lat 16-56 Long 36-15

Sunday the 17th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
N.E. and fine weather steering by the wind
Lat 16-44 Long 36-48

Monday the 18th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N.E.
and fine weather steering one way and the
other Van a pinback
Lat 17-25 Long 36-48

Tuesday the 19th
begins with light winds from the N.E. and
fine weather steering to the South middle and
latter parts brisk gales steering by the wind
Lat 18-10 Long 36-20

Wednesday the 20th
all these 24 hours light buffling winds with
equal of rain steering one way and the other
Van pinbacks Van a Bark steering to the
Eastward Lat 18-21 Long 36-38

Thursday the 21st
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the N.E.
with equal of rain steering one way and the
other Van sail in light Van porpoises
Lat 18-38 Long 36-40

Friday October the 22nd 1858
begins with moderate gales from the N.E. and
fine weather steering by the wind middle part
much the same latter part brisk gales
Van a Bark Van pinbacks and humpbacks
Lat 18-48 Long 36-32

Saturday the 23rd
begins with brisk gales from the N.E. and equally
weather steering one way and the other by the
wind Van humpbacks
Lat 18-12 Long 36-40

Sunday the 24th
begins with light buffling winds and equally
weather steering to the Eastward by the wind
middle and latter parts brisk gales from
the S.E. and thick weather steering to the East
Van a Whaling Bark
Lat 18-04 Long 36-10

Monday the 25th
begins with light buffling winds and cloudy
weather steering one way and the other by the
wind middle and latter parts much the
same
Lat 18-20 Long 36-50

Tuesday the 26th
begins with moderate gales from the East
and equally steering by the wind middle part
steering to the South at 6 PM Van a Bark
Whales going quick to the windward lowered
and chased at 12 M took up the boats
Lat 19-10 Long 36-35

Wednesday the 27th
begins with brisk gales steering to the South by
the wind Van a Bark takes a Whale at 5 M lowered
and chased till dark latter part Van nothing
