

Wednesday February the 23th 1857
begins with light winds from the S.E. and
fine weather steering to the Westward at 6 PM
at 12 came to anchor in 8 fathoms Red head bearing
S.W. A boat up English river at 12
in the boat returned

Thursday the 24th
begins with light winds from the S.E. and
good weather at 1 PM got underway and
steered to the Westward in various depths
of water from 8 to 12 fathoms at 4 PM
came to anchor in 7 fathoms the Port bearing
S.W. distant 1 mile

From the 24 to the 10 of March
lying at English River employed in
sailing and wintering

Thursday March the 10th
at 7 AM got underway steering to the
Eastward at 11 calm came to anchor in
6 fathoms

Friday the 11th
begins with calm and a head tide middle
part light winds from the East latter
part light air from the S.W. at 9 AM got
underway steering S.E. by E at 11 AM calm
with a head tide came to anchor middle
part light wind East latter part
brisk gales from the S.E. at 9 AM got
underway steering to the Eastward

Saturday the 12th
begins with moderate gales from the S.E. and
a heavy tide middle and latter parts brisk gales
from the S.E. and S.W. at 8 AM got underway
at 10 cleared the shoals steering to the Eastward
by the wind Lat 25 46 Long 33 15

Sunday March the 13th 1857
begins with brisk gales from the S.E. steering S.E. by E
by the wind middle and latter parts brisk gales
from the S.E. and S.W. steering to the South by
the wind Lat 26 31 Long 33 48

Monday the 14th
begins with brisk gales from the S.E. and
rough weather steering to the S.E. by the wind
Lat 28 55 Long 34 50

Tuesday the 15th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the S.E. and rough
weather steering to the Eastward by the wind
Lat 28 56 Long 36 13

Wednesday the 16th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the S.E. and
good weather steering to the Eastward by the
wind some sailing
Lat 29 13 Long 37 28

Thursday the 17th
all these 24 hours moderate haphling winds
and good weather steering by the wind one way
and the other working to the Southward
Lat 28 54 Long 37 10

Friday the 18th
begins with light winds from the S.E. and
moderate weather middle part moderate gales
from the South steering S.E. by E latter part
brisk gales from the S.E. and S.W.
Lat 28 56 Long 37 36

Saturday the 19th
begins with strong gales from the S.E. and S.W. and
steering S.E. by E middle part much the same latter part
more pleasant Lat 28 17 Long 38 20
