the other by the wind employed in hauling

Wednesday the 8th
begins with brisk gales from the South
and rugged weather steering to the Eastward
employed in hauling at 10 P.M. finished
was nothing Lat 4-20 Long 54-05

Thursday the 9th
begins with strong gales from the S & E and
rugged weather steering to the Eastward middle
and latter parts steering W S W
Lat 4-44 Long 52-58

Friday the 10th
all these 24 hours strong gales from the South
and rugged weather steering by the wind
Lat 5-16 Long 50-08

Saturday the 11th
all these 24 hours strong gales from the South and rugged
weather steering by the wind some pinbacks
Lat 5-53 Long 48-15

Sunday the 12th
all these 24 hours strong gales from the S & E and
rugged weather steering by the wind to the S W
Lat 6-51 Long 48-00

Monday the 13th
all these 24 hours strong gales from the S & E and
rugged weather steering to the Eastward by the
wind Lat 7-47 Long 46-20

Tuesday June the 14th 1857
begins with strong gales from the S & E and
rugged weather steering to the S W by the wind
middle and latter parts steering to the Eastward
Lat 7-32 Long 46-45

Wednesday the 15th
begins with strong gales from the S & E and rugged
weather steering to the Eastward by the wind middle
part the same latter part steering to the Eastward
some pinbacks Lat 7-24 Long 47-15

Thursday the 16th
begins with strong gales from the S & E and rugged
weather steering to the S W middle and latter
parts hard gales with heavy squalls lying too
under double reefed main topsail and reefed fore
sail Lat 7-37 Long 46-12

Friday the 17th
all these 24 hours hard gales from the S & E and
rugged weather steering to the Eastward lying
too under short sail Lat 7-50 Long 45-06

Saturday the 18th
begins with hard gales from the S & E lying
too under short sail middle part the same
latter more moderate steering to the Eastward
under double reefed topsails
Lat 8-18 Long 44-35

Sunday the 19th
all these 24 hours strong gales from the S & E and
rugged weather steering to the Eastward by
the wind Lat 7-42 Long 45-12
