all these 24 hours brisk gales from the S.E. and
rugged weather steering to the Eastward by the wind
by the wind Lat 4-00 Long 46-28

Tuesday the 21st
all these 24 hours strong gales from the S.E. and
rugged weather steering to the Eastward by the
wind and fine back Lat 6-25 Long 47-50

Wednesday the 22nd
begins with brisk gales from the S.E. and
rugged steering to the Eastward middle part
much the same latter part more moderate
steering to the S.W. by the wind and fine back
Lat 6-35 Long 48-27

Thursday the 23rd
begins with brisk gales from the S.E. and
good weather steering to the Westward by the
wind middle and latter parts strong gales
and rugged Lat 4-53 Long 49-20

Friday the 24th
begins with strong gales from the S.E. and
rugged weather steering to the S.W. middle part
hard gales latter part more moderate
Lat 7-02 Long 45-50

Saturday the 25th
begins with brisk gales from the S.E. and rugged
weather steering to the S.W. middle
and latter parts much the same as sail in
sight Lat 10-47 Long 44-24

Sunday June the 26th 1859
begins with moderate gales from the S.E. and
good weather steering S.S.W. middle part
steering to the Eastward latter part steering
S.S.W. by the wind Johanna in sight
Lat 11-31 Long 44-38

Monday the 27th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calm steering to the Southward by the
wind the Land and a ship in sight
Lat 11-55 Long 44-45

Tuesday the 28th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and fine
weather at 12 we came to anchor at Johanna in
12 fathoms and remained there until the 14th of
July weathering, painting and repairing ship

Thursday July the 14th
begins with light baffling winds and good
weather at 3 P.M. we got underway steering to the
Westward latter part steering S.S.W.
Lat 12-40 Long 43-16

Friday the 15th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the S.E. and
variable weather steering by the wind and a
fine back no bbs Lat 13-15 Long 42-48

Saturday the 16th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the S.E. and
clear weather steering by the wind and a bark
Lat 13-10 Long 41-50

Sunday the 17th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the S.E. and
rugged steering by the wind
Lat 13-18 Long 42-20
