Sunday the 31st
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
South and good weather steering one way
and the other the Land and Brig in sight
Lat 13-20 Long 41-45

Monday August the 1st
begins with moderate gales from the S.E.
and good weather steering to the North
middle and latter parts steering one way
and the other by the wind
Lat 12-50 Long 41-20

Tuesday the 2nd
all these 24 hours moderate baffling winds
working to the South the Land in sight
Lat 13-30 Long 41-10

Wednesday the 3rd
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms working to the Southward the Land
in sight Lat 14-05 Long 41-02

Thursday the 4th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms Lat 14-25 Long 40-50

Friday the 5th
all these 24 hours light winds and
calms steering to the S.W. the Land in
sight Lat 14-30 Long 40-52

Saturday August the 6th 1859
begins with light winds from the E.S.E. and
fine weather steering to the Westward at 5
P.M. came to anchor at Vernon Island Bay
in Viti Patom's latter part employed in
cutting masts

From the 6th to the 12th
employed in cutting and getting off masts at
Vernon Island Bay

Sunday the 12th
begins with fine weather at 4 P.M. finished
sawing middle part steering west at 6 P.M.
got underway steering to the S.E. with the wind
from the West wind pleasant
Lat 14-09 Long 41-00

Saturday the 13th
all these 24 hours light winds from the S.E. and
fine pleasant weather steering S.E.
Lat 13-25 Long 42-15

Sunday the 14th
all these 24 hours light winds from the S.E. and
calms with fine weather steering S.E. some a
Brig Lat 12-35 Long 42-50

Monday the 15th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms with fine weather steering to the Eastward
Mokilla and Camara in sight
Lat 12-25 Long 43-25

Tuesday the 16th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms and fine weather steering to the
Eastward the Land in sight
