Thursday the 3rd
begins with light airs from the S by E and
fine weather steering N by W middle and
latter parts light winds from the S by E
Lat 810 Long 60-33

Friday the 4th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
S by E and fine weather steering S by W
Van pinbacks Lat 735 Long 59-18

Saturday the 5th
begins with light winds from the S by E and
fine weather steering S by W middle part
largely by latter part steering S by W
Lat 625 Long 58-26

Sunday the 6th
all these 24 hours light winds and calms
steering S by W middle part largely by Van
nothing Lat 605 Long 57-38

Monday the 7th
all these 24 hours light winds with squalls
of rain steering S by W Van for pails
Lat 500 Long 57-24

Tuesday November the 1st 1859
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms with squalls of rain steering to the
South Lat 422 Long 57-52

Wednesday the 2nd
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms steering to the Southward by the wind
Lat 359 Long 58-20

Thursday the 3rd
begins with moderate gales from the N by W
and fine weather steering to the South middle
part much the same latter part steering
to the S by W Lat 304 Long 58-28

Friday the 4th
begins with brisk gales from the N by W steering
to the S by W middle and latter parts steering
to the South by the wind
Lat 209 Long 58-56

Saturday the 5th
begins with brisk gales from the N by W and
generally weather steering to the South middle
and latter parts steering to the S by W
no obs Lat 220 Long 59-00

Sunday the 6th
begins with brisk gales from the West
and generally rainy weather steering to the
S by W middle part much the same latter
part steering S by W
