Saturday December the 10th 1859

Sunday the 11th
begins with calms middle and latter parts
light winds from the N.W. & steering to the N.W.
the Land in sight Lat 3-35 Long 55-43

Monday the 12th
all these 24 hours light-buffling winds and
calms with much rain
No Obs.

Tuesday the 13th
all these 24 hours light-buffling winds
and calms steering to the N.W. saw
finbacks Lat 3-20 Long 55-12

Wednesday the 14th
begins with light-buffling winds and calms
middle part much the same latter part
~~going on the ice~~ with much rain steering to the
Westward No Obs.

Thursday the 15th
begins with light-winds from the N.W. & W and
thick rainy weather steering to the S.W. middle
and latter parts light-buffling winds
with rain No Obs.

Friday the 16th
begins with light-buffling winds and
usually weather steering by the wind middle
and latter parts much the same
