Sunday the 15th
begins with moderate gales from the
N by E and fine weather steering to the
Westward middle part by by latter part
steering S by W Lat 4-07 Long 54-24

Monday the 16th
begins with light winds from the N by E and
fine weather steering West middle part
by by latter part steering N by W
Lat 4-26 Long 54-11

Tuesday the 17th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from
the N by E and fine weather steering N by W
Lat 5-15 Long 51-56

Wednesday January the 18th 1860
all these 24 hours light winds from the N by E
with showers of rain steering N by W some
porpoises Lat 5-45 Long 50-44

Thursday the 19th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N by E
and fine weather steering N by W some
porpoises Lat 6-12 Long 50-25

Friday the 20th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N by E
and fine pleasant weather steering N by W
some porpoises Lat 6-24 Long 49-50

Saturday the 21st
all these 24 hours calm some porpoises
Lat 6-12 Long 49-45

Sunday the 22nd
begins with calm middle and latter parts
of moderate breezes from the South steering
N by W Lat 7-04 Long 48-20

Monday the 23rd
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
North and fine weather steering S by W some
porpoises Lat 8-22 Long 46-33

Tuesday the 24th
begins with moderate gales from the South
and fine weather steering S by W middle part
by by heading N by W latter part steering
S by E Lat 11-00 in view the Island of
Alakabra bearing S by E distant 18 miles
