

Saturday March the 24th 1860
begins with strong gales from the N.W. and
niggled equally weather steering to the
Westward by the wind middle part hauled
Upwards steering to the N.E. latter part more
moderate saw the bottom in 12 fathoms
two sail in sight Lat 9.42 Long 60.53

Sunday the 25th
begins with brisk gales from the N.W.
and good weather steering to the N.E. middle
and latter parts fine weather steering N.W.
by the wind two sail in sight
Lat 9.30 Long 61.08

Monday the 26th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N.W.
and fine weather steering by the wind three
sail in sight latter part on the Bank in
13 fathoms of water.
Lat 9.43 Long 60.45

Tuesday the 27th
all these 24 hours light huffling winds
and fine weather steering one way and
the other spoke the ship under 21 months
out with 350 bbls sperm oil two sails in
sight Lat 9.20 Long 60.46

Wednesday the 28th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
N.W. and fine weather steering by the wind
two sail in sight spoke the ship
Thomas Pope Captain Robbins 8 months
out with 250 bbls sperm oil

Lat 9.23 Long 60.07

Thursday March the 29th 1860
all these 24 hours light winds from the N.W.
and fine weather steering by the wind one
sail in sight Lat 9.25 Long 60.58

Friday the 30th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N.W.
and fine weather steering by the wind one
sail in sight Lat 9.36 Long 60.50

Saturday the 31th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the N.W.
and good weather steering by the wind one
sail in sight Lat 9.40 Long 60.36

Sunday April the 1st
begins with brisk gales from the N.W. and
good weather steering by the wind middle and
latter parts equally spoke the ship Hope
Captain Macfarlan 8 months out clear
Lat 9.46 Long 60.32

Monday the 2nd
begins with brisk gales from the N.W. and squally
weather steering to the N.W. middle part steering
N.E. latter part steering N.E. one sail in
sight Lat 9.30 Long 60.05

Tuesday the 3rd
begins with light winds from the West and
fine weather steering N.W. middle part
steering East latter part steering N.E. by 9
one glimpses Lat 9.34 Long 61.30

Wednesday the 4th
all these 24 hours light huffling winds
and calms steering various ways one
sail in sight Lat 9.35 Long 61.30
