all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms steering to the Westward and
pinback two sail in sight
Lat 9-36 Long 60-50

Friday the 6th
all these 24 hours calms and fine weather
one sail in sight
Lat 9-37 Long 61-00

Saturday the 7th
begins with calms middle part light winds
from the SE and fine weather steering NE
latter part steering SE by the wind some
pinbacks Lat 9-42 Long 60-40

Sunday the 8th
begins with moderate gales from the ESE
and fine weather steering to the South latter
part brisk gales with squalls of rain
some porpoises Lat 10-56 Long 60-31

Monday the 9th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the SE
and rugged weather steering by the wind some
nothing Lat 11-21 Long 60-34

Tuesday the 10th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from
the SE and fine weather steering by the
wind Lat 11-30 Long 60-30

Wednesday the 11th
all these 24 hours strong gales from the SE
and rugged squally weather with much
rain thunder and lightning
No Obs Lat 12-26 Long 60-50

Thursday April the 12th 1860
begins with brisk gales from the SE and
rugged squally weather steering to the SE
middle and latter parts more moderate
Lat 9-42 Long 61-03

Friday the 13th
all these 24 hours light winds from the East
and fine weather steering by the wind saw
bottom in 12 fathoms and caught some
fish

Saturday the 14th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
ESE and fine weather steering NE by N
saw porpoises Lat 9-00 Long 61-20

Sunday the 15th
all these 24 hours light winds from
the ESE steering to the North with fine weather
saw porpoises Lat 7-49 Long 61-20

Monday the 16th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
fine weather steering to the North
Lat 7-26 Long 61-16

Tuesday the 17th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms steering to the Northward a
sail in sight Lat 6-49 Long 61-04

Wednesday the 18th
begins with light baffling winds and
fine weather steering to the SE middle
part much the same at 6 A.M. some
specimen whales going SE at 8 lowered at
12 M. stretch to the Starboard boat
