Sunday the 6th
begins with calms middle and latter parts
moderate gales from the N^W and good
weather steering to the North by the wind
Lat 3-53 Long 57-15

Monday the 7th
all these 24 hours baffling winds and
equally weather steering to the Westward
some finbacks Lat 3-36 Long 56-48

Tuesday the 8th
begins with baffling winds and equally
weather steering to the Westward middle and latter
parts moderate gales from the N^W steering
to the N^W by the wind some finbacks
Lat 3-58 Long 56-36

Wednesday May the 9th 1860
begins with moderate gales from the N^W
and fine weather steering to the S^W by the
wind middle part steering to the North latter
part steering to the N^W some the David
Lat 3-52 Long 45-20

Thursday the 10th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
Westward and fine weather steering by the
wind the David in sight some porpoises
Lat 3-27 Long 55-58

Friday the 11th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
Westward steering by the wind the David in
sight some blackfish
Lat 3-25 Long 56-08

Saturday the 12th
all these 24 hours moderate baffling winds
with showers of rain steering by the wind
some Lat 3-08 Long 56-04

Sunday the 13th
all these 24 hours baffling winds and
equally steering by the wind
Lat 2-55 Long 56-00

Monday the 14th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms with showers of rain steering
to the Westward some finbacks
