

Monday July the 23th 1860
begins with moderate gales from the
S and fine weather steering to the East
middle part much the same latter part
strong breezes and rugged
Lat 4-08 Long 45-09

Tuesday the 24th
begins with brisk gales from the S
and rugged weather steering to the ESE
middle part steering SSW latter part
steering to the East with moderate
weather Lat 4-00 Long 44-36

Wednesday the 25th
all these 24 hours moderate baffling
winds with squalls of rain steering by
the wind and a fair back
Lat 4-36 Long 45-14

Thursday the 26th
begins with light baffling winds and
rainy weather steering to the SSW
middle and latter parts steering to the
SE and fair back
Lat 4-15 Long 44-00

Friday the 27th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms steering to the Eastward by
the wind Lat 4-42 Long 44-43

Saturday the 28th
begins with calms middle part
light winds from the S and fine
weather steering to the Eastward
latter part squally
Lat 5-04 Long 45-18

Sunday July the 29th 1860
begins with moderate gales from the S
and fine weather steering to the Eastward
middle part steering to the SSW latter part
steering to the Eastward by the wind and
fair back Lat 5-58 Long 45-36

Monday the 30th
all these 24 hours light winds from the South
and fine weather steering by the wind and
fair back Lat 6-02 Long 46-18

Tuesday the 31st
all these 24 hours light winds from the South
and fine weather steering by the wind and
blackish Lat 6-20 Long 45-48

Wednesday August the 1st
all these 24 hours light winds from the South
and fine weather steering by the wind and
the storm of Atlantic bearing East 2 miles
Lat 6-30 Long 46-46

Thursday the 2nd
begins with light winds from the South and
fine weather steering to the SSW middle
and latter parts baffling and squally
Lat 6-31 Long 46-36

Friday the 3rd
begins with baffling winds and squally
weather steering by the wind while fine
much the same latter pleasant and
fair bearing SSW
Lat 6-49 Long 46-58
