the E S E and fine weather steering to
the South Lat 10 27 Long 44 50

Tuesday the 11th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
E S E and fine weather steering by the wind
the Land in sight saw a French Bark
Lat 10 08 Long 43 50

Wednesday the 12th
begins with light winds from the E S E
and fine weather steering W S W middle
part calm latter part light winds from
the South steering East a strong S current
Lat 10 45 Long 45 30

Thursday the 13th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
South and fine weather steering E S E the
Land in sight
Lat 12 15 Long 44 20

Friday the 14th
begins with moderate gales from the S S W
and fine weather steering N E middle and
latter parts much the same the Land
in sight Lat 11 44 Long 44 56

Saturday the 15th
begins with light winds from the East
steering to the N E S E middle part calm
latter part light baffling winds with
squalls of rain
Lat 17 32 Long 44 40

Sunday September the 16th 1860
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and squally rainy weather steering to
the N E Lat 16 00 Long 44 30

Monday the 17th
begins with light winds from the S E and
good weather steering to the S E middle and
latter parts calm saw pinbacks
Lat 11 24 Long 44 10

Tuesday the 18th
begins with calms middle part the same
latter part light winds from the South and
fine weather steering to the Eastward
11 39 Long 44 07

Wednesday the 19th
begins with light winds from the South
and good weather middle and latter parts
calm employed in skimming oil
Lat 11 30 Long 44 10

Thursday the 20th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms steering to the Eastward saw porpoises
Lat 11 34 Long 44 08

Friday the 21st
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms steering to the S E saw porpoises
Lat 11 45 Long 44 20

Saturday the 22nd
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms steering to the South saw pinbacks
the Land in sight
