Wednesday, the 10th
begins with light winds from the East and
fine weather steering S.E. middle part
the same latter part light winds from
the S.E. steering to the S.W. at 11 A.M.
fell in with a boat with three black men
in her took her along side found the men
very sick they say that they have been
ten days without provisions or water
but I think probably five days would
come nearer the truth they say they come
from the Isl of France but that is
impossible at any rate they are coming
from some where most likely St. Paul
they speak no English but some French

begins with light winds from the S.E.
and fine weather steering S.E. by S middle
part calm latter part light winds from
the S.E. steering S.E.

Friday, October the 12th 1860
all these 24 hours light winds from the S.E.
and fine weather steering by the wind one
way and the other by the wind and porpoises
Lat 4-13 Long 43-02

Saturday, the 13th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
S.E. and fine weather steering by the wind
and finbacks and porpoises
Lat 4-11 Long 43-22

Sunday, the 14th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
S.E. and fine weather steering by the wind
and porpoises Lat 4-25 Long 43-10

Monday, the 15th
begins with brisk gales from the S.E. and
good weather steering S.E. middle part the
same latter part steering S.W. and nothing
Lat 5-25 Long 42-38

Tuesday, the 16th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the
S.E. and good weather steering S.W.
Lat 6-45 Long 41-28

Wednesday, the 17th
begins with moderate gales from the S.E.
and good weather steering S.W. middle
part steering by the wind one way and the
other latter part steering S.W. by S at 11
A.M. saw the Island of Yamouhar bearing
N.E. by E Lat 6-25 Long 39-50
