Monday November the 19th 1860
all these 24 hours light winds from the N E
and fine weather steering by the wind employed
in cooping oil Van's blackfish
Lat 00 10 N Long 50 00

Tuesday the 20th
all these 24 hours light winds from the N E
and fine weather steering by the wind
employed in cooping and storing oil
Lat 00 06 N Long 50 05

Wednesday the 21st
all these 24 hours light winds from the N E and
fine weather steering by the wind Van's porpoises
Lat 00 14 North Long 50 45

Thursday the 22nd
all these 24 hours light winds from the N E
and fine weather steering by the wind
Lat 00 37 N Long 50 00

Friday the 23rd
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
with squalls of rain steering one way
and the other by the wind Van's finbacks
Lat 00 38 N Long 50 38

Saturday the 24th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms with showers of rain steering to
the S E Van's finbacks
Lat 00 07 N Long 50 00

Sunday the 25th
all these 24 hours baffling winds and
squally weather with plenty of rain
Van's finbacks 10 o'clock
