

Monday December the 10th 1860
all these 24 hours light winds from the NNE
and fine weather steering to the Eastward
Lat 40.30 S Long 51.22

Tuesday the 11th
begins with calms and fine weather
steering to the Eastward middle and latter
parts moderate gales from the NE
Lat 40.12 South Long 51.25

Wednesday the 12th
begins with light winds from the North
and fine weather and no fish steering
to the Eastward middle and latter parts
steering to the Westward
Lat 40.15 South Long 51.26

Thursday the 13th
begins with light winds from the NNE
and fine weather steering to the NNE middle
and latter parts steering to the Eastward
Lat 40.42 Long 51.33

Friday the 14th
all these 24 hours light winds from the
NE and good weather steering to the
Eastward by the wind and fine backs
Lat 40.58 Long 52.53

Saturday the 15th
begins with light winds from the North
and fine weather steering to the Eastward
latter part steering South
Lat 41.13 Long 53.28

Sunday December the 16th 1860
all these 24 hours light winds from the NNE
and fine weather steering S 8 E at 10 AM
two breeches Lat 41.13 Long 54.20

Monday the 17th
begins with light winds from the NNE
and fine weather steering South at 1 PM
two sperm Whales lowered and got two
struck another and lost the line at 5 got
the Whales to the ship middle part long by
latter part cutting at 10 AM finished
Lat 42.24 Long 54.31

Tuesday the 18th
begins with light winds from the NNE
and fine weather steering to the Westward
by the wind employed in hauling middle
part the same latter steering to the NE
Lat 42.31 Long 54.33

Wednesday the 19th
begins with light winds from the NNE
and fine weather steering to the NE employed
in hauling at 8 PM finished middle and
latter parts steering S 8 E by the wind
Lat 42.48 Long 55.05

Thursday the 20th
all these 24 hours light buffing wind
and calms steering to the Westward by the
wind
Lat 42.20 Long 55.10

Friday the 21th
all begins with calms middle part the
same latter part light winds from
the East steering N 8 W
Lat 42.52 Long 55.20
