

Saturday January the 19<sup>th</sup> 1861  
begins with moderate gales from the ESE  
and rainy weather steering to the N.E. by the  
wind middle and latter parts moderate  
breezes from the N.W. and pleasant  
steering to the ESE.

Lat 3.58 Long 53.36

Sunday the 20<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours variable winds and  
and weather steering to the N.E. saw the  
Land North Island.

Lat 3.37 Long 54.08

Monday the 21<sup>st</sup>  
begins with brisk gales from the N.E.  
middle and latter parts moderate and  
fine weather steering by the wind  
saw Blackfish V. and Bird Island

Lat 3.35 Long 54.51

Tuesday the 22<sup>nd</sup>  
all these 24 hours moderate gales from  
the N.E. and good weather steering by the  
wind latter part steering to the South  
the Land in sight

Lat 3.53 Long 55.20

Wednesday the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
begins with moderate buffling winds  
steering to the South at 5 AM we came  
to anchor at Whaling middle part  
Generally rainy weather at 7 AM  
received orders to have no communication  
with the shore got underway and  
went to sea bound to Akahua

Thursday January the 24<sup>th</sup> 1861  
begins with light buffling winds and  
Generally steering to the Westward middle part  
by latter part steering to the North

Friday the 25<sup>th</sup>  
begins with light buffling winds and  
showers of rain at 4 PM took a boat but  
had to come to anchor at 8 outside of the  
harbour at 6 AM got underway at 9  
came to anchor in port Victoria Harbour  
Alaska where we lay until the 5<sup>th</sup> of February  
the last 2 days wind bore at 6 AM  
got underway and went to sea steering to  
the Eastward

Saturday January the 26<sup>th</sup>  
begins with brisk gales from the N.E. and  
cloudy weather steering to the N.E. middle  
part the same latter part steering to the  
Westward a Vail in sight

Lat 4.23 Long 57.05

Sunday the 27<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the  
N.E. and rugged weather steering by the wind  
a Bark in sight Lat 4.32 Long 56.45

Monday the 28<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours strong gales from the N.E. and  
rugged weather steering by the wind  
two Vail in sight

Lat 5.04 Long 57.15

Tuesday the 29<sup>th</sup>  
begins with brisk gales and rugged  
steering West middle and latter parts strong  
gales and rugged steering to the Eastward  
Lat 4.50 Long 58.02
