has lost 6 miles saw blackfish
Lat 12-16 Long 44-14

Tuesday the 16th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms steering to the S^W the Johanna 12 miles
off a strong current setting S^W saw
Shore steering to the Eastward

Wednesday the 17th
all these 24 hours light baffling winds
and calms steering to the S^W the Land
10 miles off

Thursday April the 18th 181
all these 24 hours light baffling winds and
calms steering to the Eastward the Land 10
miles off a Steamer in sight

Friday the 19th
begins with light winds and baffling steering
to the Eastward at 9 M we came to anchor
at Johanna in 12 fathoms water
From the 19th to the 23th
lay at anchor employed in recruiting
Ship

Tuesday the 23th
at 9 AM got under way steering to
the Eastward at 12 M passed Middle Island

Wednesday the 24th
all these 24 hours brisk gales from the
South and rugged weather steering one way
and the other by the wind the Islands for
Johanna Margotta and Mohilla in sight
Lat 12-54 Long 44-36

Thursday the 25th
all these 24 hours moderate baffling winds
and fine weather steering to the Eastward
Four porpoises Lat 13-43 Long 44-17

Friday the 26th
all these 24 hours light winds from the S^W
and fine weather steering S^W by the wind
saw a finback Lat 14-30 Long 45-05

Saturday the 27th

and calms steering S^W
