lying to Noobs Lat 35 10 Long 24 37.

Sunday the 26th
begins with moderate gales from the
Westward and a heavy sea running from
all quarters middle part the same latter
part moderate gales from the North
and pleasant steering West Union Vail
Lat 35 27 Long 22 15

Monday the 27th
begins with moderate gales from the North
and good weather steering N by N middle
and latter parts hard gales from the S^W
lying too heading S^W No Obs

Tuesday the 28th
begins with hard gales from the S^W and
heavy weather lying to heading to the S^W.
latter part heavy gales from the West
Shaped a sea and broke the Starboard
main rail stove bullmarks

Wednesday the 29th
begins with hard gales from the S^W and
heavy weather lying too middle and latter
more moderate steering S^W
Lat 36 05

Thursday the 30th
begins with moderate gales from the S^W
steering North middle and latter parts hard
gales from the S^W lying too heading S^W
Lat 35 50 Long 20 50

Friday May the 31st 1861
begins with brisk gales from the West and
clear weather steering S^W middle part
moderate gales from the S^W steering S^W
latter part much the same
Lat 35 52 Long 20 15

Saturday June the 1st
begins with moderate gales from the West
and cloudy weather steering S^W middle
part winds from the S^W steering S^W
latter part strong gales from the S^W and
thick rainy weather steering to the North
Lat 36 12 Long 19 23

Sunday the 2nd
begins with brisk gales from the S^W and rough
weather steering to the North middle part steering
S^W by the wind latter part strong gales from
the S^W steering S^W with a heavy sea on
Lat 35 38 Long 18 40

Monday the 3rd
begins with brisk gales from the S^W and rough
weather steering S^W middle and latter parts
brisk gales from the S^W steering S^W
Lat 34 47 Long 15 45

Tuesday the 4th
begins with brisk gales from the S^W and
good weather steering S^W middle part brisk
gales from the North and rough weather
steering S^W Lat 33 40 Long 15 16

Wednesday the 5th
begins with strong gales from the S^W lying
to heading S^W middle part hard gales
latter part moderate gales from the S^W steering
S^W Lat 33 15 Long 15 30
