S^E and fine weather steering N^W some
pinbacks Lat 26-45 Long 10-57

Monday the 10th
all these 24 hours moderate gales from the
S^E and fine weather steering to the
South some pinbacks Lat 25-13 Long 10-37

Tuesday the 11th
all these 24 hours light winds from the South
and cloudy weather steering N^W some
pinbacks Lat 24-04 Long 9-52

Wednesday the 12th
all these 24 hours light winds from the South
and fine weather steering to the North
some pinbacks
Lat 22-35 Long 9-48

Thursday the 13th 1861
begins with light winds from the South and
fine weather steering North middle part the
same latter part steering S^E
Lat 20-54 Long 9-56

Friday the 14th
all these 24 hours light winds from the S^E
and fine weather steering to the N^W
Lat 21-30 Long 8-53

Saturday the 15th
begins with light winds from the S^W and
fine weather steering S^W middle part
by by heading to the Eastward latter
part steering S^E some pinbacks
Lat 21-16 Long 9-12

Sunday the 16th
begins with moderate gales from the S^E
and fine weather steering to the East middle
and latter parts brisk gales and rugged
steering N^W some humpbacks

rugged weather steering one way and the
other some pinbacks Lat 19-31 Long 8-05
