

Bark Sea Fox Towards New Holland

Friday Nov. 22^d Comes in with fine weather and moderate trade winds the Bark Steaming S.E. Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing of importance Lat 24.35 Long 29.22

Saturday Nov. 23^d Comes in with fine weather and moderate trade winds the Bark Steaming S.E. Middle part Squally Latter part Fresh Breezes Saw nothing Lat 22.30^W Long 27.23 W
Lunar obs. 27.07 W

Sunday Nov 24th This day Comes in with light winds from the S.E. the Bark Steaming South Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing but Blackfish Lat 19.35^N Long 26.38

Monday Nov. 25th Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark on the Starboard tack Lowered our Boats for Blackfish and Caught 2 Small ones at Sunset Shortened Sail. Latter part Saw a Shoal of Spum Whales Lowered our Boats and the Starboard & Waist Boats Saved a Small Whale Each. The Whales were going about North quite fast, but then in Lat 18.28^N Long 26.19.

Tuesday Nov 26th First part fine weather Employed Blowing away the Whales heads and Cutting blubber Started the Works about 11 AM at 3 P.M. Saw Whales Breaching Struck one the Sun almost down and Sailed to the Ship about Dark Lat 18.19^N Long 26.19 W

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Wednesday Nov 27th Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark Laying with a Whale alongside boiling latter part cutting in finished about 11 A.M. Saw Breaches but Could not make out what they were. at Sunset Saw Whales Lat 18.00^N Long 26.40 W

Thursday Nov 28 This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds from the S.E. Middle and latter part much the same at 9 A.M. Saw Whales going quick to Windward Lowered our Boats without Success, the Whales went off quick to windward Lat 17.05^N Long 26.19

Friday Nov 29 This day Comes in with fresh trades and Squally weather the Bark heading to the Southwards Boiling Middle part heading to the North. Saw several vessels at 2 P.M. Saw St Antones Burney E.S.E. by Comp about 20 miles, finished Boiling. Lat 17.00^N

Saturday Nov 30th First part of this day fine weather and moderate breezes from the S.E. Steaming N.W. middle and latter part much the same. Ends with moderate breezes. Lat 18.10^N Long 25.41 W.

Sunday Dec 1st This day Comes in with fine weather and fresh breezes from the S.E. Steaming on different tacks Middle part much the same Saw something making white water but could not tell what was no more of it Lat Long
