

Bark Sea Fox Cruising for Whales.

Friday Dec 13th Comes in with good weather and fresh breezes the Bark heading on different tacks middle and latter part much the same. Saw finbacks and other small fays. Ends with fine weather
Lat 18.11 N Long 26.13

Saturday Dec 14th These twenty four hours fresh breezes and clear weather the Bark heading on different tacks middle and latter part moderate. Saw finbacks and porpoises. At noon the Island of St. Anthony bearing E. by S. 15 miles.

Sunday Dec 15th Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds from the S.E. the Bark standing to the Southwards, saw the Island of Fogo, bearing S.E. 15 miles.

Monday Dec 16. This day fine weather and moderate winds from S.E. the Bark steering by the Wind heading S.E. 1/2 E. Saw the Island of St. Jago, Middle and latter part nearly Calm.

Tuesday Dec 17th Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds the Bark steering to the Southward middle and latter part Calm, lowered for blackfish and caught one,
Lat 14.54 Long 23.37

Wednesday Dec 18th Comes in with fine weather and light winds the Bark laying off & on at Porto Praya at 4 P.M. Come on Board with 6 hogs, and oranges & Bananas, fowls &c. latter part standing off shore.

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Thursday Dec 19th Comes in with fine weather and light winds from the N.W. the Bark heading on different tacks. Saw Blackfish and Caught 4. Small ones. Ends with Calm weather. Saw Finbacks.

Friday Dec 20th This day Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds from the N.E. the Bark steering S.W. by S. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw porpoises at noon the Island bearing North. 55 miles.

Saturday Dec 21st These twenty four hours fine weather and light winds the Bark steering S.W. by S. Middle and latter part much the same. Ends with fine weather
Lat 12.25 N Long 23.40

Sunday Dec 22^d First part of this day good weather and moderate winds from N.E. the Bark steering S.W. by South. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with gentle trade.
Lat 10.30 N Long 23.45

Monday Dec 23^d This day fine weather and moderate winds from the N.E. steering S.W. Middle and latter part fine Wholesail breezes. Saw several Merchantmen. Employed setting up 16 Ball Rigging. filling new rib. pendants
Lat 8.18 N Long 24.25 W
Lunar hrs. 24.25

Tuesday Dec 24th These twenty four hours fine weather and pleasant breezes from the N.E. steering S.W. Saw a ship standing to the Northward.
