Saturday March 1st This day Comes in with fine weather and light northerly winds the Bark steering E. S. E. middle part moderate. Ends with light Breezes. Saw one vessel steering to the Eastward

Sunday March 2^d Comes in with light winds from the North, steering E. S. E. at sunset lowered for Blackfish and saved three. Middle and latter part Calm. a sail in sight to the Westward
Lat 39.15 S Long 65.20 E.

Monday March 3^d This day moderate weather and whelsail Breeze from the S. E. the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing employed Boiling Blackfish

Tuesday March 4th Comes in with fine weather and moderate winds from the S. E. the Bark on the Wind, on different tacks. Middle and latter part nearly calm. Saw nothing of importance
Lat 38.00 Long 66.25 E.

Wednesday March 5th These twenty four hours light winds and Calms with rain squalls the Bark working to the S. E. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fine weather
Lat 37.55 S

Thursday March 6th Comes in with fine weather and moderate Breeze from S. S. W. the Bark steering E. S. E. by E. Middle and latter part much the same. Ends with light winds from N. E. Saw Compuers. and lowered for them, without Success.
Lat 38.15 S Long 68.00 E.

Friday March 7th First part light Breezes and fine weather steering E. S. E. Middle and latter part fresh northerly winds. Saw nothing. Ends with fine weather
Lat 38.40 S Long by Chron 71.39 E
Lunar do. 71.25 E

Saturday March 8th Comes in with fresh Breeze from North the Bark steering E. S. E. Middle and latter part much the same. Saw Blackfish but did not lower
Lat 38.35 S Long 73.35 E

St. Pauls
Sunday March 9th These twenty four hours fine weather and moderate Breeze from North the Bark steering E. Middle part much the same. Ends with strong Breeze and rainy weather at 1 P.M. Saw the Island of St Pauls bearing E. by N. 15 miles
Lat 38.38 S

Monday March 10th Comes in with rainy weather and fresh Breeze from N. W. the Bark lying off and on at St Pauls latter part two Boats in fishing. Caught about one Bush took up the Boat and steered off E.
