

1862. Bark Sea Fox. Cruising on New Holland

Sunday March 23rd. This day Comes in with fresh breeze from West the Bark Steering N.E. Middle part the Wind from S.W. veering to the Southwards. Saw nothing of importance. Lat. 30.40° Long 105.40°

Monday March 24th. Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the Bark Steering N.E. by E. Middle and latter part much the same, at sunset Shortened sail latter part repairing the fore sail saw one furback. Lat 28.42° Long 106.13.6.

Tuesday March 25th. Comes in with fresh trades and Squally Weather the Bark on the Eastern tack Middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing. Ends with fresh Breeze. Lat 27.20° Long 107.56° E.

Wednesday March 26th. Comes in with fine Weather and moderate trades the Bark heading to the Eastwards at 11 AM Saw Whales going quick to windward. Lowered two Boats for them without success. Lat 27.00° Long 108.30° E.

Thursday March 27th. This day Comes in with fresh trade Winds the Bark standing on different tacks middle and latter part much the same saw nothing of importance. Lat 27.15° Long 107.53° E.

Friday March 28th. Comes in with fresh trades and Squally the Bark heading to the S.W. at sunset tacked to the Eastwards at daylight saw Whales going quick to Windward. did not lower. no chance. Lat 26.38° Long 108.19° E.

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Saturday March 29th. Comes in with strong trade and Squally Weather the Bark Steering to the Eastward by the Wind Middle and latter part much the same. The Ship Sighting in Sight. boats fast to Whales. We lowered two Boats. But Could not get there in time latter part. Strong breeze. Saw one vessel. Saw Whales going quick to windward. Lat 26.05° Long 108.36° E.

Sunday March 30th. Comes in with strong trade Winds the Bark heading to the Southward Middle and latter part more moderate. Saw nothing. Ends with fine Weather. Spoke the Ship Sighting 21 months. 1400. Spinn. Lat 26.00° Long 108.41° E.

Monday March 31st. This day fine Weather and moderate trade Winds the Bark on the Southern tack middle and latter part much the same. Saw no fish. the Sighting in Sight standing to the Eastward. Lat 26.50° Long 108.18° E.

Tuesday April 1st. Comes in with good weather and moderate Winds from the Southwards the Bark on different tacks middle and latter part the Weather about the same. repairing fore top Gall^{ty} sail one vessel in Sight. Lat 26.58° Long 108.13° E.

Wednesday April 2nd. Comes in with fine Weather and moderate trades the Bark heading on different tacks middle and latter part much the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with fresh trades. Lat 27.20° Long 107.46° E.
