

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on New Holland

Monday April 14th Comes in with fine
Weather and moderate Winds from the S.E. the
Bark heading to the Eastwards. middle and
latter part much the same. all hands employed
Stowing down oil in the main Hatchway. one vessel in
sight. Lat 26.00 S Long 107.52 E

Tuesday April 15th This day Comes in with fine
Weather and rough Sea. The Bark on the Southern
tack Middle and latter part much the same.
Saw nothing of the fish kinds. one vessel in sight
Lat 26.40 S Long 107.18 E

Wednesday April 16th Comes in with fresh
Weather and equally Weather the Bark on different
tacks. Middle and latter part much the same
Saw no fish. Ends with better Weather
Lat 25.30 S Long 107.42 E

Thursday April 17th This day Comes
in with light Breezes from the S.E. the Bark on
different tacks middle and latter part much the
same. Employed breaking out to find a leak in the
oil. The pumps show a little querry. but I have broke
out and looked at nearly all the Casks but can find none
leaking. I think it is old Curry. that Comes to the pumps
by getting the Bark down by the Head. as I have put all
the last Whale forward of the main hatch.
Lat 26.25 S Long 107.28 E

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Friday April 18th These twenty four hours fine Weather
and light air from the Southwards the Bark on different tacks
Middle and latter part much the same. Ends with light
Breezes from S.W. the Bark Stowing S.E. saw few backs
Lat 26.25 S Long 108.03 E

Saturday April 19th Comes in with fine Weather and
light air from S.W. the Bark Stowing S.E. Middle and
latter part nearly Calm. Saw few backs and
porpoises. Ends with light air from the South
Lat 26.28 S Long 108.18 E. Chosen
Lunar at 10.23

Sunday April 20th This day Comes in with
light air from S.E. the Bark heading to the Eastwards
at daylight lashed to the S.W. saw a few fin backs
and porpoises. Ends with light Weather
Lat 26.48 S Long 108.15 E

Monday April 21st Comes in with fine Weather and
light Breezes from the Eastwards. Middle and latter part
nearly Calm. Saw nothing of importance. Ends with a Calm
Employed fitting a new Boat.
Lat 27.07 S Long 107.52 E

Tuesday April 22^d. Comes in with fine Weather
and moderate Winds from the Westwards the Bark
on the Southern tack. at 4 P.M. Saw a large Whale
and lowered for him but could not get to him as
he had. but one rising before dark. Middle part Calm
latter part Stowing on different tacks. Saw nothing
Lat 27.07 S Long 108.05
