

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on New Holland

Wednesday April 23<sup>rd</sup>. Comes in with fresh Breezes from South the Bark Staring to the Westward Middle and latter part Squally at 4 P.M. Saw Whales and lowered for them. The Starboard Boat Struck and Saved the Whale and got him to the Ship about 8 P.M. Latter part Cutting Cut off the head and got the Jaw in. Saw a Whale Spout, supposed to be a Spinn Whale. Lat 26.50 S Long 107.48

Thursday April 24<sup>th</sup>. Comes in with fresh Breezes and Squally Weather the Bark With a Whale alongside. all hands Employed Cutting rolled the Body in, and trying to hook on to head. The Chain parted and lost the head. Middle and latter part fresh Breezes. The Bark on different tacks saw one Vessel supposed to be the Leaping. Lat 26.40 S Long 107.30

Friday April 25<sup>th</sup>. This day Comes in with fresh Trades and Squally Weather the Bark on different tacks. Employed boiling Saw nothing of importance one Vessel in sight. Lat 26.38 S Long 108.21 E

Saturday April 26<sup>th</sup>. This day Strong Trades and Squally Weather the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part the Weather about the Same. Saw nothing of importance. finished boiling The Leaping in sight. Lat 26.33 S Long 108.12 E

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Sunday April 27<sup>th</sup>. These twenty four hours fresh Trades and Squally Weather the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part the Weather about the Same. The Leaping in sight to windward. Saw no fish. Lat 26.42 S Long 108.46 E.

Monday April 28<sup>th</sup>. Comes in with fine Weather and moderate Breezes from the South the Bark on the Eastern tack Middle and latter much the Same Employed Stowing down, oil in the main hatch. Lat 26.40 S Long 108.42 E.

Tuesday April 29<sup>th</sup>. Comes in with moderate Breezes from the S.E. the Bark Staring to the S.W. Middle and latter part much the Same. Saw finbacks. Spoke the Bark Java and Ship Leaping. Ends with good weather. Lat 27.05 S Long 107.46 E

Wednesday April 30<sup>th</sup>. Comes in with fresh Breezes and Squally Weather the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the Same. Saw finbacks. Ends with fresh Breezes. Lat 26.33 S Long 108.27 E

Thursday May 1<sup>st</sup>. Comes in with fresh Trades and Clear Weather the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the Same. Ends with Strong Breezes. Saw no fish the Bark Java in sight. Lat 26.50 S Long 108.18 E
