

Bark Sea Fox Cruising on New Holland
Tuesday May 13th Comes in with light winds
from the S.W. the Bark steering to the Eastward
Middle and latter part the Wind blowing to the East
Saw nothing of importance.
Lat 26.12° Long 110.22° E

Wednesday May 14th This day Moderate winds
and light weather the Bark steering West by
the Wind Middle and latter part much the same
Saw finbacks and porpoises. Ends with fine weather
Lat 26.19° Long 109.15° E

Thursday May 15th Comes in with moderate Breezes
from S.W. the Bark steering S.W. Middle and latter
part much the same. Saw a few finbacks. Ends
with light weather.
Lat 26.50° Long 107.49° E

Friday May 16th This day Comes in with light air
from the S.W. the Bark steering N.W. at 1 P.M. Saw
a Ship Putting in and run for her. at 3 P.M. Saw another
vessel Whaling. Made all sail and steered for her. got there
about Sunset. and lowered the Boats. But too late to get
to the Whales before dark. Spoke the Leaping and Wawa
Lat 26.06° Long 107.55° E

Saturday May 17th Comes in with moderate winds
from the S.W. the Bark steering on different tacks
Middle and latter part much the same. Saw several
vessels. Ends with light weather.
Lat 26.00° Long 107.45°

Sunday May 18th These twenty four hours
fine weather and moderate Breezes from the North.
the Bark steering S.S.W. Middle and latter
part much the same. Saw nothing of importance.
Spoke the Leaping and got a Fluke Chain from
her.
Lat 26.08° Long 108.01° E

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Monday May 19th Comes in with fresh Breezes
from the W.N.W. the Bark steering S.S.W. Middle
and latter part the Wind N.W. steering N.E.
Saw finbacks. The Leaping in sight steering to
the N.W.
Lat 26.25° Long 108.00°

Tuesday May 20th Comes in with fresh Breezes
from the Westward the Bark on the Eastern tack at times
lacked to the N.W. Middle and latter part the Wind from
the Southward steering to the Westward. Saw finbacks and
Squid.
Lat 26.35° Long 107.34° E. From
107.50° Lunar

Wednesday May 21st Comes in with
Moderate winds from the Southward the Bark
on different tacks. Middle and latter part much
the same. Saw nothing of importance. Ends
with light winds.
Lat 26.10° Long 108.20°

Thursday May 22^d This day Comes in with Squally
Weather and rain the Bark steering to the S.S.W. Middle
and latter part much the same. Saw finbacks and
other small fish. Spoke the Kathleen
Lat 26.48° Long 107.21° E

Friday May 23^d This day fine weather and moderate
winds from the S.E. steering off N.W. Middle and latter
part light winds. Saw nothing of importance. Saw one
vessel.
Lat 26.30° Long 107.16°

Saturday May 24th This day fine weather and moderate
Breezes from the S.E. steering to the N.E. saw one
vessel. Ends with a Calm.
Lat 26.30° Long 107.20°
