Sunday May 25th Comes in with Moderate Breezes and Rain Squalls the Bark heading on different tacks Middle part raining. Ends with Calm Saw nothing of importance No obs.

Monday May 26th Comes in with moderate Breezes from the Southward the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the same Saw Killers and lowered for them without Success. Ends with fine Weather Saw the Seapwing Lat 24.45. Long 107.40 E.

Tuesday May 27th Comes in with Squally Weather and Variable winds the Bark on different tacks Middle part moderate, latter part heavy squalls from N.W. at 9 AM was struck by lightning and had the fore Royal Mast broke off two feet above the eyes of the Rigging and also Splinters taken out of the fore topmast and fore gullt mast. Went to work and sent down the fore top gullt mast and Rigging. The fore topmast is not injured enough to do any harm. The Ship Seapwing in Company Lat 26.40 S Long 107.56 E

Wednesday May 28th Comes in with fresh Gale from the Westward the Bark lying to under Close reef Main top sail and fore topmast stay sail heading to the North one vessel in sight, the Seapwing. Latter part more moderate Lat 23.50 S Long 108.04 E

Thursday May 29th Comes in with fresh Gale from the Westward the Bark steering to the North Middle and latter part much the same Ends with moderate Breezes Lat 25.35 Long 108.26

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Friday May 30th Comes in with Gentle trade winds Clear Weather the Bark steering to the North Middle and latter part much the same Saw a few fimbicks. The Seapwing in Company Lat 25.10 Long 108.40

Saturday May 31st Comes in with light Weather and Calms the Bark on different tacks Middle and latter part much the same Saw nothing Ends with light winds Lat 24.40 108.45

Sunday June 1st Comes in with rainy weather and squalls the Bark steering off S.W. Middle and latter part moderate and rainy. Spoke the Kathleen and the Seapwing. Ends with Westerly Winds. Lat Long

Monday June 2^d Comes in with fresh Breezes from the Westward steering off N.E. Middle and latter part fresh Breezes. Saw a Merchantman. the Seapwing in Company. Lat 24.50 S Long 109.44

Tuesday June 3^d This day Comes in with light winds from the Southward the Bark steering E.N.E. Middle and latter part, quite moderate without the fore topsail to repair, and shifted the fore topsail to the main The Seapwing in sight, steering to the Eastward Lat 23.56 S Long 110.43 E.

Wednesday June 4th Comes in with light Breeze from the S.E. the Bark steering to the E.S.E. Middle and latter part light air and Calms Saw nothing. The Ship Seapwing in Company 11.38 Sun
